

Presentation for Introducing the District Banner Ribbon

MEET WITH PRESIDENT ABOUT PRESENTING THE CLUB WITH THIS RIBBON



1. Introduce yourself: District 55 is presenting _____ with a distinguished club Banner ribbon to hang on your banner.
2. You will notice this year's district theme is "Members in Motion."
 - We encourage our members to be in motion (achieving goals) at the club, area, division and district level.
3. Notice the two sets of squares numbered 1-6 and four squares labeled 7-10
4. The abbreviation at the top of the squares stands for :
 - C.P our Current Program. 1-10 of the Distinguished Club Program
 - T.P.L.E is the abbreviation for the Toastmasters Pathways Learning Experience. 1-10 of that program.
 - Both programs use the 7-10 goals of membership building (7-8, 9 Club Officer Training and 10 Submitting your new officer lists on time and paying your dues on time ONE time in the year.
5. For example, when your members achieve 2 CC awards in your club, you can put a football in Goal 1 of the Current Program. If they also have 4 new members submitted to TI, you can put a football in goal #7.
6. The Toastmasters Pathways Learning Experience will be launched early in 2018...Feb/Mar. All NEW members have to be put into the Pathways program.
 - Other members can choose to stay in the CP for up to 2 years if they desire to do so.

7. This banner and football display will give your club a picture of the goals your members achieve. I will leave you the information on the Current Program, so you can enter your members education awards they achieve.
