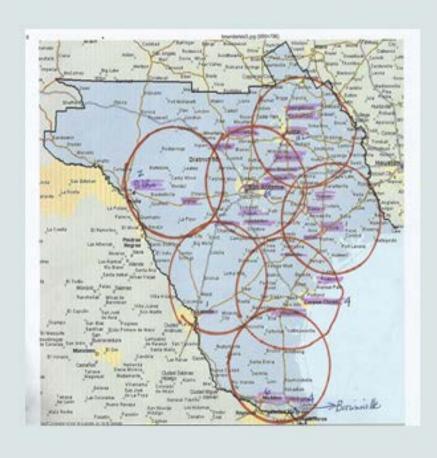

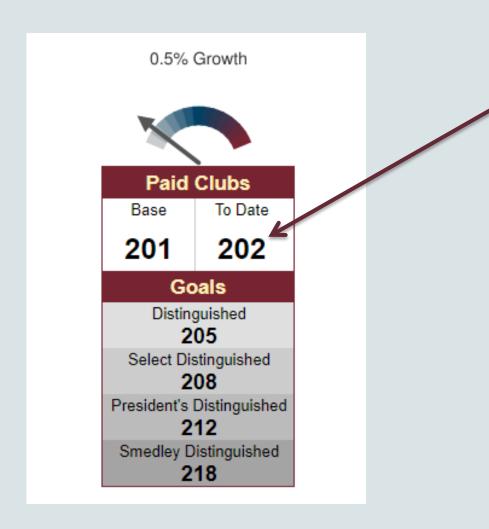

#### Focus

- 2019-20 Distinguished Club Goal: Base: 201 Clubs need 101 Distinguished Clubs for President's Distinguished status
- DCP Report as of this week:
  - 7 Clubs have 5+ points
  - 11 Clubs have 3-4 points
  - 83 Clubs have 1-2 points
  - 129 Clubs have no points
- Educational Achievements: 293
  - 204 for Pathways
  - 89 for the Traditional Program



## Focus (Cont'd)

- Quality Training for our Leaders, Club Officers, and members: We're off to a decent start.
  - Nearly 60% of Club Officers have been trained, we can do better next time!
  - 72% Area and Division Directors met minimum of 4 hours of training Today's training will get us to TI required 85%
- Club Mentoring Programs
  - We started the conversation, now we need to build resources



#### **Hopes & Dreams**

- Every member, Club officer, and District Leader feels supported and empowered to achieve their goals
- Every club embraces Moments of Truth and plans for success through the DCP Program
- Every club participates in a speech contest
  - Clubs should conduct Contests in January, or early February
  - Areas should conduct Contests in February or early March
  - Divisions should conduct contests in April
  - District 55 contests will be held mid-May in Corpus Christi
- > We are innovative and breaking new ground this year

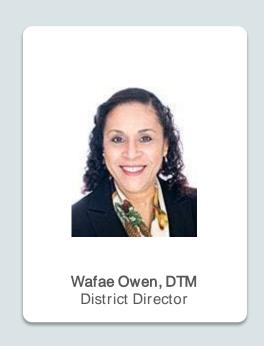


#### Coming Soon

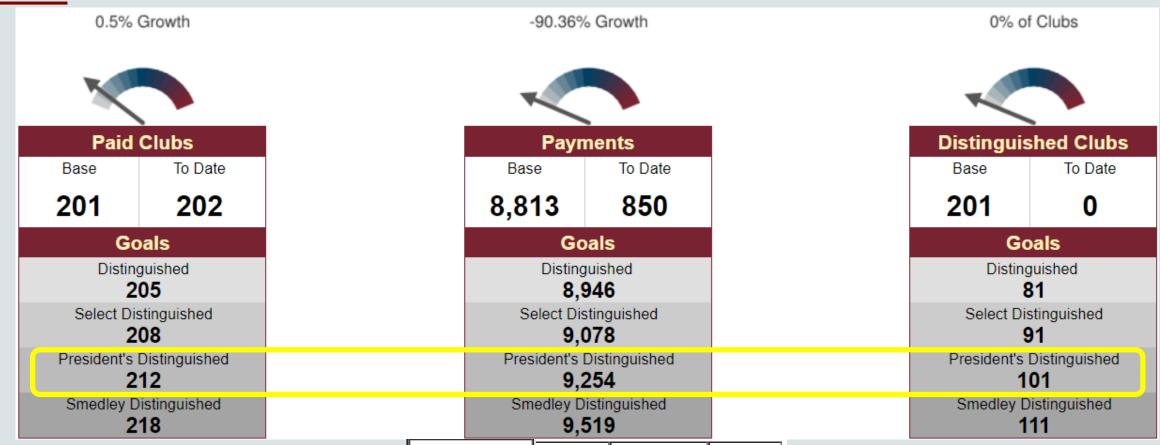
