- 9. The Administrative Manager's Report was given Amy O'Neil, CC, CL. The Minutes for May 4, 2016, and June 4, 2016, were made available and copies at the meeting minutes are online. No objection was made to dispensing with the reading of the minutes. The May 4,2016, minutes could not be approved at the June 4, 2016 meeting due to the lack of quorum. There were no corrections. Social Media is about to be reviewed, revitalized, and reenergized for District 55 starting with District 55 Facebook group. This is an internal communication for our members to stay abreast of events in the District, encourage club members to use D55 Facebook and request membership.

In order to educate District & Club officers better in PR, Bill will be sending out monthly and quarterly emails with topics & suggestions on how to grow stronger and better clubs with PR

- B. The Club Growth Director's report was given by Melody Moore, DTM by video. Goals set by TI for this year:
 - 1) 6 brand new clubs with no net club loss to be Distinguished
 - 2) 10 brand new clubs with no net club loss to be Select Distinguished
 - 3) 16 brand new clubs with no net loss to be President Distinguished.

If we lose any current clubs we need to replace them along with getting the 6, 10, or 16 brand new clubs. We are planning on getting at least a minimum of 16 new clubs.

There is a club in Austin that has already had their demo meeting and are on their way to establishing a club, and a club in San Antonio that will have a demo meeting before the end of July.

Please encourage existing clubs to have open houses to build membership early

C. The Program Quality Director's report was given by Linda Oliver, DTM

PQD Team: D55 is now on Easy Speak, clubs not on Easy Speak are called summary clubs and they are in the process of getting the officers of those summary clubs on Easy Speak, so that we, as District leaders, can communicate with the officers.

There will be more training for the District on How to Use Easy Speak

The VPE Chair is Blanche Pape. She is going to communicate with VPE's of each club and keep them informed on what needs to be done at the club level. Bart Loeser will be the chair of membership retention for program quality clubs. Rikitta Hughes and Michelle Harper will have training for the contests. Toastmaster 101, PDG Atheria Scott has done a video for new member orientation and is on the District 55 website so that all clubs may use the video
